

REGISTRATION

1. Why are there different registration fees?

The symposium brings together participants from different sectors and regions. A tiered registration structure allows participation from international organisations, African institutions, and youth or student participants while supporting the costs of hosting the convening.

2. Who qualifies for each registration category?

Participants should select the category that best reflects their organisation or affiliation.

INGOs, Donors, and High-Income Country Governments:

Participants representing international development organisations, donor agencies, and governments from high-income countries.

African Governments, National and Community Organisations, Consultants:

Participants representing African government institutions, national organisations, regional or national NGOs, community-based organisations, and independent consultants from and in the region.

Youth and Students:

Young professionals, youth leaders, and students currently enrolled in academic institutions.

3. What does the registration fee include?

Registration covers:

- Access to all symposium sessions
- Symposium materials
- Tea and lunch during the event
- Networking opportunities with participants across research, policy, and practice

4. When does early bird registration close?

- Early bird registration is available until 31 March 2026 at 23:59 EAT.
- Regular registration is available until 30 April 2026 at 23:59 EAT.
- Late registration will be open (pending space) until 31 May 2026 at 23:59 EAT.

5. How can I pay for my registration?

In the registration form, there are two different options for payment, online via credit card or offline via the Symposium organizer's bank.

Credit card: You can process the payment directly on our website and receive your registration confirmation immediately.

Offline payment: Please complete the registration form, indicate you would like to do an offline payment in the payment section, and submit your registration. You will receive an invoice from the Symposium planning team (within 4 days) with our bank information to send a wire transfer. Your registration will not be confirmed until payment has been received.

6. Is the registration fee refundable?
